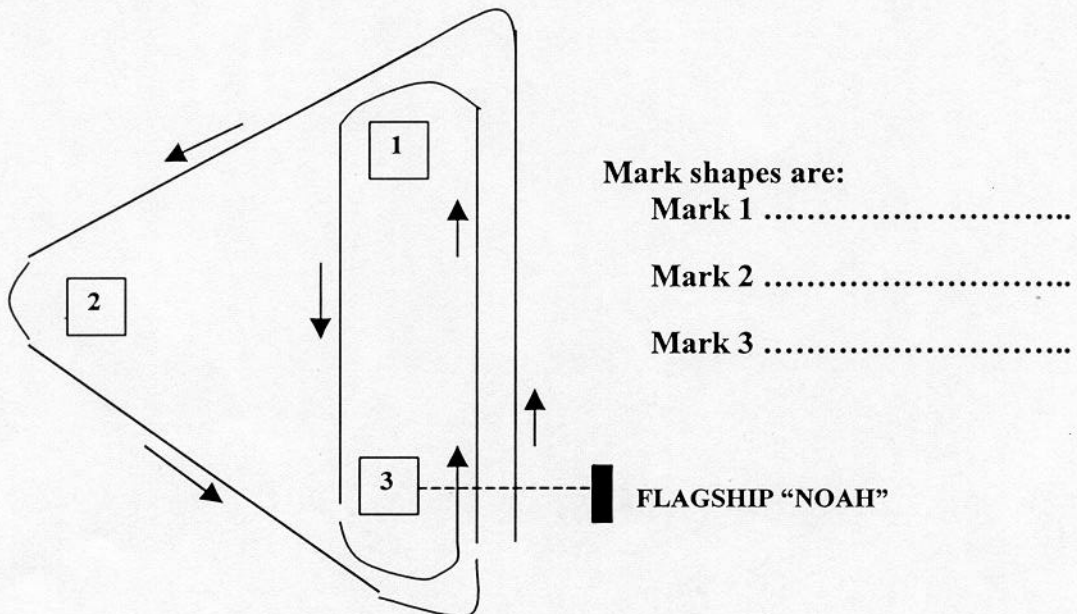

The Start: Between the mast of the flagship “Noah” and Mark 3, leaving the flagship to starboard.

The Course: The first and subsequent odd rounds will be:

- Mark 1 (Port)
- Mark 2 (Port)
- Mark 3 (Port)

Through the line on the legs from Mark 3 to Mark 1, leaving the flagship to starboard

The second and subsequent even rounds will be:

- Mark 1 (Port)
- Mark 3 (Port)

Through the line on the legs from Mark 3 to Mark 1, leaving the flagship to starboard

Continue until shortened

If the flagship is flying a green flag at the preparatory signal this indicates that all marks are to be taken to starboard instead of port and the flagship is to be taken to port instead of starboard.

Shortened Course: When the leading boat has rounded the last mark and the shortened course has been indicated, boats should finish directly between the mast of the flagship and Mark 3, taking **the shortest distance from the last mark through the finish line**. However, if the Race officer so decides, the race may be finished between a race committee boat flying a blue flag and an adjacent mark.
